


Arts Week - Reception

The kids have had a great time this week learning about African culture and art. We started the week by jet setting off to Africa on our class airline and looking at the globe of the world to find out where we were headed. We created beautiful silhouette pictures, inspired by safari sunsets, using special dyes to create a background and then cutting out animals in black sugar paper to showcase the wildlife. We looked at a video about Maasai Mara children living in Kenya and had the chance to wear a real Maasai necklace that was lent to us by Mrs Bowden-Green, who lived in Africa. We then used a paper plate to make our own necklaces and added paint, sticks, straws and pipe cleaners to create the bead patterns on the original. We were able to learn a special African dance with a dance instructor and move like a lion. A specialist music teacher also taught us an African song called Kye Kye Kule and let us explore the sounds of African instruments.









<u> Arts Week – Year 1</u>

Rabbit and Owl Class really enjoyed exploring the many art and craft activities inspired by the vibrant continent of Africa. Some of their favourite art work included Giraffe drawings with added Adinkra Symbols for a background. We were pleased that each giraffe looked different and had its own individual and quirky expression.

Sunsets across African savannahs were the inspiration for all year groups to practice their colour mixing skills. The Year 1 classes started with yellow paint and gradually mixed in varying amounts of red paint to create these amazing coloured skies. The children then cut out some silhouettes of African animals to complete the African sunset scene.

Rabbit and Owl Class also learned about Ndebele Art and how bold geometric patterns can be used to decorate houses and buildings. We made houses out of cardboard and decorated them with our own colourful Ndebele patterns.



















As well as lots of arts and craft activities, we also enjoyed taking part in African drumming and dance workshops. A great time was had by all!











<u>Arts Week – Year 2</u>

Year 2 had a brilliant week learning about Africa and creating some African inspired pieces of art. First, they found out about the continent and countries of Africa, and the Egyptian Pyramids. They carefully followed a tutorial in order to create a 3D drawing of the Great Pyramid of Giza, which they painted using watercolours. Next, they researched different African animals. They experimented with mixing primary colours to create pink and orange shades and used these to create a sunset background. Then they chose their favourite animals to sketch, before copying them onto black paper and cutting them out to create silhouettes against their sunsets. Some of them chose to add Baobab and Acacia tree silhouettes to their pictures. We finished the week by looking at traditional African clothing, and having a go at weaving. It was tricky but we persevered!

As well as developing our Art skills, we took part in a drumming workshop where we had the chance to try out different percussion instruments and create a piece of music. We also took part in a Lion King inspired dance workshop. We really enjoyed our music and dance!







World Book Day



Our focus for the day was poetry and all year groups had a fun-filled day doing activities based around a poem. We also held a competition for children to decorate a potato as a book character, and we were amazed with the quality of the entries. Well done to all children who took part!





For World Book Day, Rabbit Class and Owl Class were given the challenge to create a poem inspired by On the Ning Nang Nong by Spike Milligan. We started by investigating a few rhyming words and onomatopoeia. We then created our own background illustrating what our nonsense world looked like and added colour using watercolours. Once it had dried, we wrote our own mini versions of the poem. Everyone worked incredibly hard, well done Year 1!

World Book Day 2024


What a brilliant last two book-related days we have had!! With our Author Visit on Wednesday and World Book Day yesterday – we have had great fun sharing our love of reading


