The Office block. In this building, you will find the school office, the staff room and Mr Webster's office.

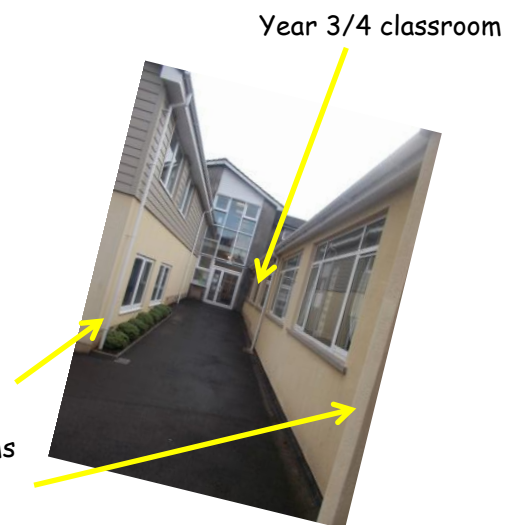
This is the School Hall. In this room, we have assembly, we eat our lunch and we do our indoor P.E. lessons.

Here is the playground. We play here first thing in the morning, at break time and during lunch. We do outdoor P.E. here too!

The Houses: **Beech**, **Sycamore**, **Oak** and **Willow**!

We meet up with our house groups for house assembly every other Tuesday. You will also compete in your house for Sports Day and for our BJS talent show: The Easter Festival!

When you impress your teachers, you will earn house points for your house and everyone hopes their house will win the house point trophy at the end of the year!

A typical day at Backwell Junior School

8.30: The school gate opens, and you are allowed onto the playground.

9.00: The bell rings. You should be in school by now! We line up in classes on the playground, and wait to be told to go into class. Your teacher will take the register and you may be asked to take the register up to the office!

9:00-9.15: While the register is taken, you will usually complete times tables task.

9.15: Lesson 1 starts. This is usually maths but this can change.

10.15: Worship. This takes place in the hall. On Mondays and Thursdays Mr Webster or Mrs Pearson will lead worship. Hymn practice or house assembly are on Tuesdays. On Wednesdays, a member of the church comes to lead worship and Friday (9:15am) is our celebration assembly.

10.40: Break time. We have our healthy snack at this time and go out onto the playground.

11:00: Lesson 2 starts. This is usually English but this can change!

12.00: Lunch time. There is a rota so you will know which classes will go to lunch first and which equipment you can play on.

1.00: Afternoon registration. The bell will ring on the playground and you and your class will return to your classroom.

1:00: During the half hour after lunch, we usually do a reading lesson.

1.30: Your afternoon lessons will start. Geography, History, Art, Music, P.E. (Physical Education) Religion and Worldviews, PHSE (Personal, Social and Health education.), French or Science.

3.30: The end of the day! If anyone other than a parent or carer is collecting you, this must be communicated to school before 3pm so that it can be recorded in our 'going home' book. There are sections for ongoing arrangements and one-off playdates.

Clubs

At Backwell Junior School, we pride ourselves in giving you the opportunity to take part in lots of different clubs!

They may either take place during lunch time or after school.
