

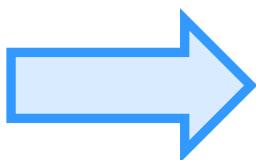

URGENT MESSAGE REGARDING FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Message from Mr Webster

Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware there are a number of changes to Free School Meals eligibility from the start of next academic year:

- Eligibility is being expanded for all children and young people who are in households in receipt of Universal Credit.
- Transitional protection is ending at the end of July 2026 (Transactional protection has been in place since April 2018 and meant that pupils becoming eligible for free meals under the benefits-based criteria have retained their entitlement for 6 years, even if their household circumstances have changed).

If your child(ren) already receive(s) free school meals:

As a result of these changes all pupils currently in receipt of free school meals will need to re-check their eligibility over the summer break. Please use this link [Free School Meals Checker - Check Eligibility Online | LGfL FSM](#) to have your child(rens) status for free school meals re-checked (view previous check).

If you have recently applied to North Somerset Council for free school meals from September 2026, then you will now need to reapply (check eligibility) using the link above.

If you want to check if your child may be eligible for free school meals:

Please use this link [Free School Meals Checker - Check Eligibility Online | LGfL FSM](#) to see if you would be eligible for free school meals from September 2026.

Free School Meals provide eligible pupils with a free school lunch during the school day.

Registering for Free School Meals may also bring additional funding into school through pupil premium.

We have noticed that the Victorians were very covered up at the beach and they used bathing machines to get in and out of the sea. As part of our local history, we have looked at how Birnbeck pier looked in the past and how it was used



Hedgehogs, Owls and Rabbits enjoyed a wonderful school trip to Clevedon Pier last week, following our history work on *seaside holidays of the past*. Despite the very warm weather, we were delighted to see so many children dressed in Victorian costumes. Many members of the public commented on how much they enjoyed seeing the children dressed up!

We loved exploring the Discovery Centre Museum, where we found out that the pier is 157 years old. The views from the Porthole Room were spectacular, giving us a unique perspective of the pier's architecture from beneath.

We enjoyed sketching this view, as well as looking at beautiful artwork and historical photographs of the pier through the years. We also explored the full length of the pier, following a discovery picture trail to spot interesting features both on the pier itself and out across the coastline.



Some children even had time to create wax crayon rubbings of the brass fish hidden on the benches.

After a busy morning, we enjoyed eating our lunch in the shade of a nearby park before making our way to the beach. The children had great fun stacking rocks, searching for sea glass and cooling down with a well-earned ice lolly while enjoying the sea breeze.



Those who attended Thursday's trip were treated to an extra-special surprise. We were lucky enough to witness the final moments of a remarkable swim all the way from Wales, arriving at the slipway just as we were leaving. It was a very exciting moment to see! We all had a fantastic day, and the children were excellent ambassadors for our school throughout the visit. Their exemplary behaviour, enthusiasm and curiosity made us incredibly proud.

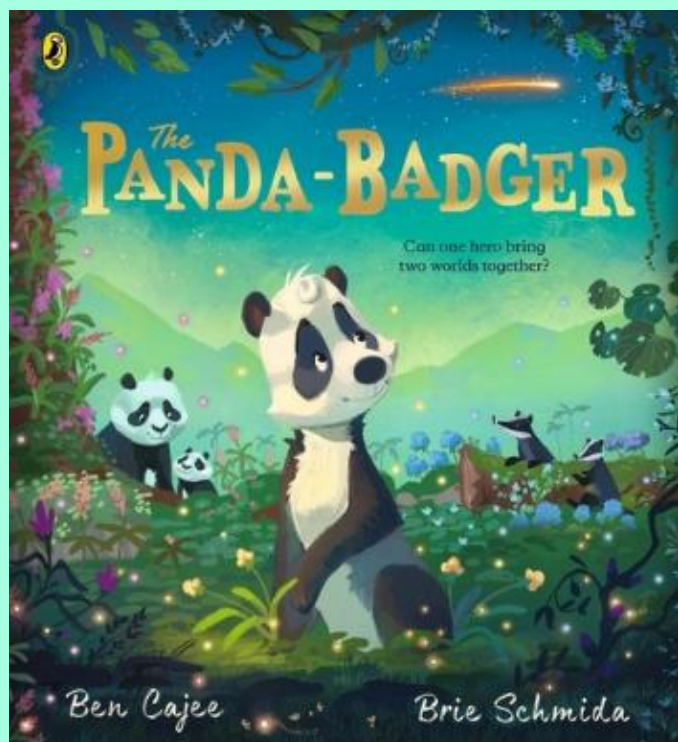
We all had a brilliant time welcoming CBeebies presenter and author Ben Cajee to West Leigh to share his new book, *The Panda-Badger*!
