

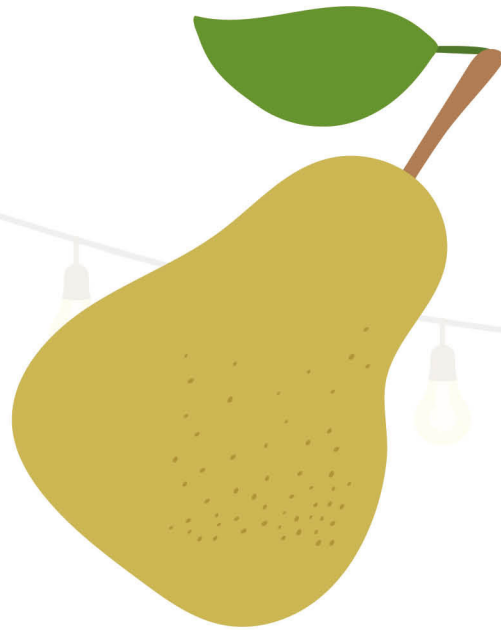

Pears are an ancient fruit that came from Western Europe, Africa, and Asia. Pear remains have been found in ruins near Lake Zurich.

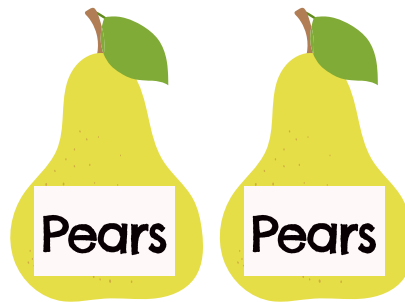
There are over 3000 varieties of pears worldwide.

Pair of Pears



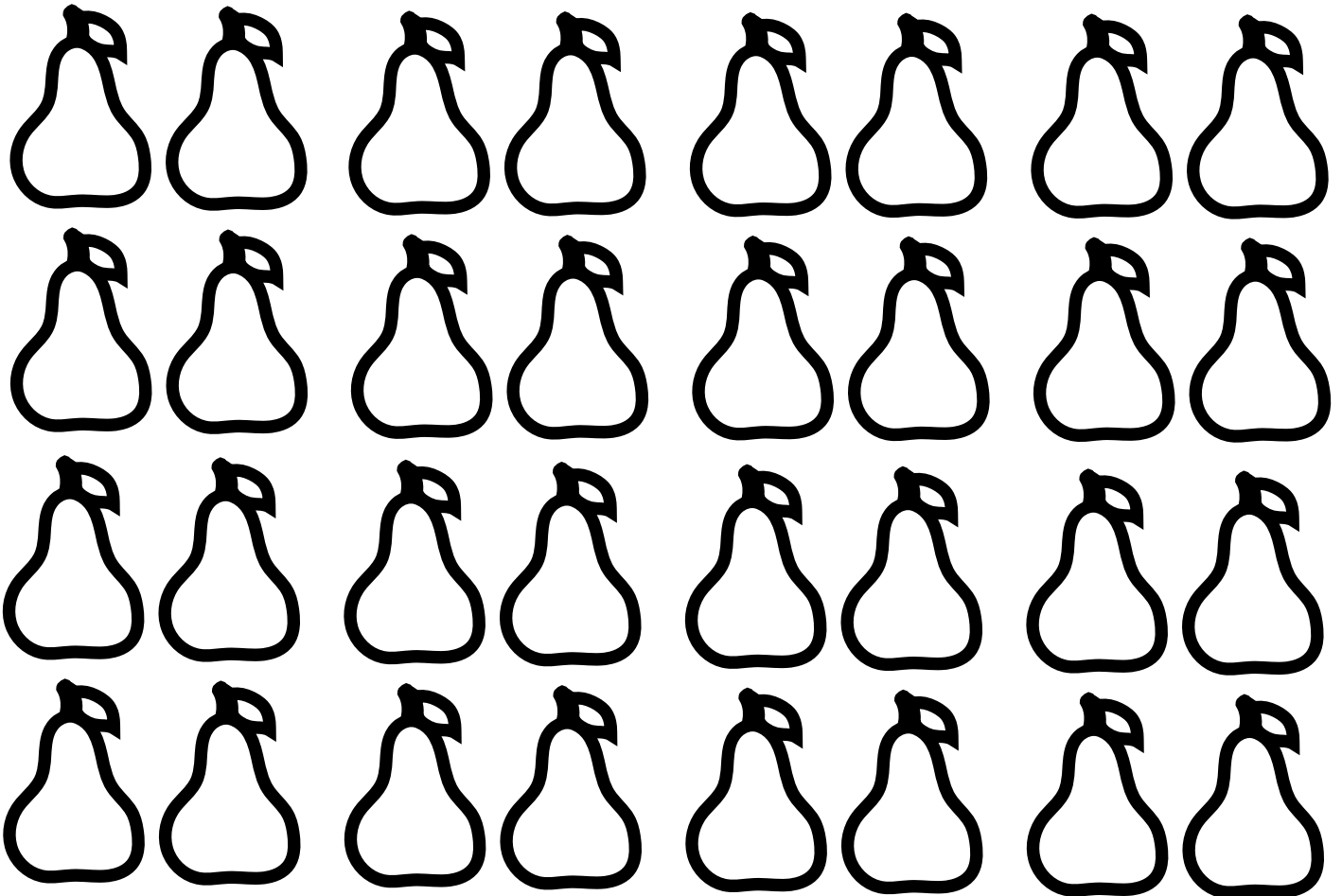
Two of more words that sound the same as another word but have a different meaning and a different spelling are called what?

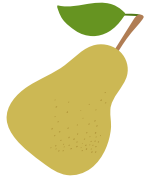

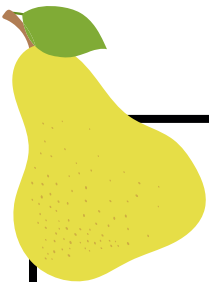
