

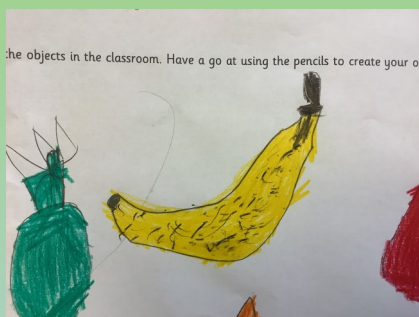


Owl Class News

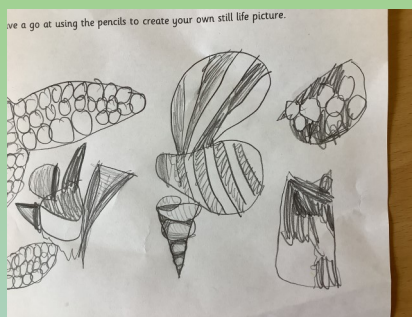

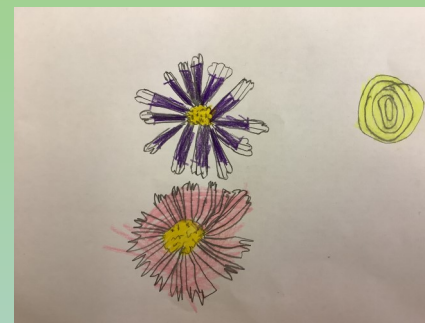
Brooke's bananas



Cole's shells



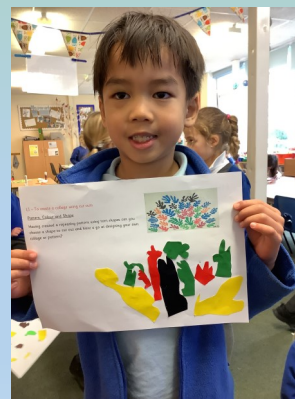
Monty's flowers
