The Book Fair is on its way! Listen out for further information over the next couple of weeks but it will be running in the school hall from Monday 28th November to Friday 2nd December!




MONTHLY MUST READS

These books are not currently on the 30 Reads list but could be added under the 'your choice' section on the 30 Reads log.


NOVEMBER
